Today, the world is experiencing an employability crisis. Employers have vacancies, but many young people do not have the appropriate skills to gain employment. There can be a gap between what education providers and what employers require. Education improves employability but there is a disconnection between the priorities of educators and the skills needed by students for employment.

With that, CIMA and IAI are pleased to jointly introduce the **Future Chartered Accountant – Chartered Global Management Accountant (CA-CGMA) Programme** for university students. This programme aims to provide an opportunity for students to gain exposure and experience the role of a Chartered Accountant and Chartered Global Management Accountant as early as in the first year of their undergraduate programme. They will participate in a series of activities throughout the duration of their university studies to help prepare them well for the workforce.

Besides, CIMA provides scholarships for all members of the Future CA-CGMA Programme to sit one subject under the CIMA professional qualification during their final year of university studies. With that, students will graduate with the university degree and an international professional qualification – Diploma in Management Accounting from CIMA. Students will be supported by both online and face-to-face training before the final exam during their final year of studies.

Students with outstanding results in their university studies will be awarded scholarship by IAI to pursue the Chartered Accountant (CA) exams. This is subject to the specific criteria set by IAI.
